### ABOUT THE INSTITUTE

- [The Ludwig Boltzmann Institute for Lung Health](#), which is part of the Austrian Ludwig Boltzmann Gesellschaft, was founded in 2002 to conduct clinical and translational pneumological research at the Pulmonary Competence Centre of the Clinic Penzing in Vienna.
- Since its foundation, the institute has conducted a wide range of research programs in the fields of lung development, chronic lung diseases (and their comorbidity) and pneumological oncology.
- The Ludwig Boltzmann Institute for Lung Health is conducting a longitudinal research project – [The Austrian LEAD study](#). This is a longitudinal, observational, epidemiological cohort study aiming to investigate respiratory health through life. The survey includes a representative sample of the Austrian general population between 6 and 80 years of age and focuses on lung growth and development, genetic, environmental and socioeconomic risk factors for abnormal lung function and extrapulmonary manifestations of abnormal lung function and related comorbidities (cardiovascular disease, metabolic disorders, depression and anxiety).
